Job Overview

?Eniyud Health Services is looking to fill two (2) positions of Home Support Workers (Health Care Aide) who under the direction of the Health Director will primary be responsible for building trust with Xeni Gwet'in members to assist and support people as needed on unique individual, family and community home and health needs. The Home Support Workers will be reporting to the Home and Community Care Manager, and working closely with the Community Health Nurse, Practical Nurse and other members of the Health Team.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities

- Ability to build trusting relationships to assist and support community members (Elders, adults) based on their unique physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual domains of health and wellness;
- Assist clients with daily activities such as taking medication, bathing, eating, dressing etc.;
- Check vitals, record and notify health professionals, as needed;
- Perform light housekeeping duties such as laundry, sweeping and mopping floors;
- Assist and support along a continuum, which takes places in community, peoples' home, on the land, or in a clinical setting;
- Community to people the purpose of Home and Community Care through various workshops, gatherings, etc.;
- Follow established, transparent policies and procedures specific to Home Support Worker (Home Care Aide) role, created based on best practices and as per Home Care Aide Certification competencies;

- Travel to client's homes, community locations, various agencies, and other outreach destinations as determined by the team;
- Provide support and advocacy when necessary for clients. Especially during medical visits to ensure clients medical needs and required referrals are being addressed. Follow up with the people after appointments to assist and support as determined by client;
- Assist with admission, transfer, and discharge of clients from ?Eniyud Health Centre;
- Under the direction of the Community Health Nurse assist with nursing care. This may include but not limited to greetings community members, providing transportation to the clinic for vaccine clinics etc.;
- Ensure strict confidentiality and privacy is maintained as per ?Eniyud Health Service Guidelines;

Qualifications:

- Certification from a recognized Care Aide (HCA) program or willing to receive certification (10 months full time)
- Previous experience in a long-term care facility preferred
- Ability to communicate effectively verbally and in writing
- Good interpersonal skills and ability to effectively interact with various individuals
- Ability to lift, squat, bend, stand and walk as required to perform certain duties
- BC Driver's License
- Criminal Record Check
- Tsilhqot'in Language
